## **LAKE KEOWEE 4-H2O PONTOON CLASSROOM**

### **LAKE KEOWEE WATERSHED SUMMER PROJECT**

**JULY 10-14, 2006**

**Would you like to spend time this summer in a classroom that meets on Lake Keowee and the subject taught is water resources? Would you like to learn by using hands-on techniques and field trips taken on pontoons? If you answered yes to these questions, the 4-H2O Pontoon Classroom project is for you.**

**The Clemson Extension Service is offering the 4-H2O Pontoon Classroom Project to youth between the ages of 8-12. The goal of the project is to instill in youth a respect for water resources. The project covers five half-day sessions. Each session is held at High Falls Park with part of the learning activities conducted from pontoons that are provided by members of F.O.L.K.S. The dates and times are as follows:**

**July 10-14 (Monday - Friday): 8:30 am - 12:30 pm each day**

**General topics taught are: The Importance of a Watershed Approach, Physical and Chemical Properties of Lake Keowee Water, Biological Properties of Lake Keowee and Fun on Lake Keowee. Participants conduct water related experiments and learn about aquatic life and how testing equipment is used to evaluate water quality. Participants also learn the basic techniques of fishing, bait-crafting, and orienteering.**

**The cost of the 4-H2O PONTOON CLASSROOM PROJECT is \$40.00 per student which includes program supplies, a morning snack, and a T-shirt. Each participant must know how to swim. The project is limited to 25 students and is on a first come, first serve basis. All eligible youth may apply, but preference will be given to first-timers. The camp is open to both 4-H and non 4-H members.**
